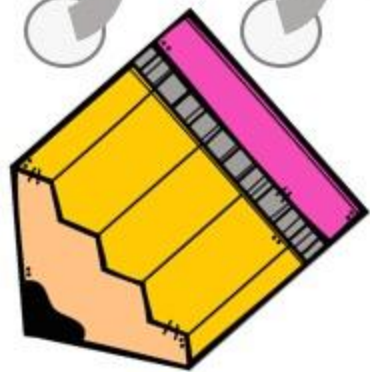

What is **POETRY**?

Poetry is a collection of words that express an emotion or idea, sometimes with a specific meaning, sound, or rhythm.



RHYME



Words that end in the same sound.

Tim and **swim** both end in the "im" sound.

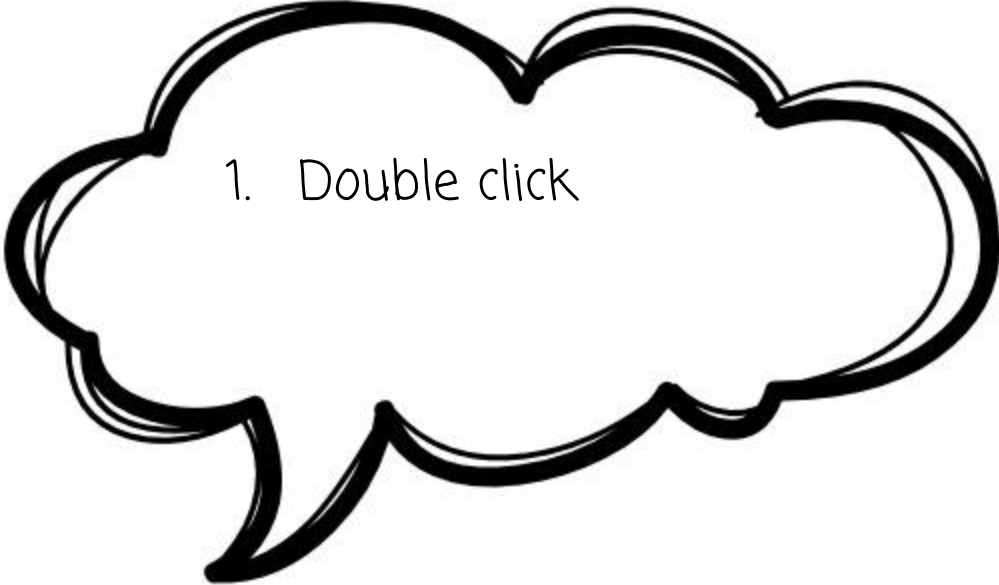
I HAVE A LITTLE FROG
